"In reaching out to the artists for material to use on this collection, I was overwhelmed not just by their generosity, but by their feeling connected directly to the girls in Kenya. With such an impact from one trip, the music on this compilation is not only beautiful in and of itself, but that beauty is magnified immeasurably by the love it connotes."
